Winter Shut-Off Policy

During the winter months of December, January, February, and March the Village of Farwell acknowledges the hardship of shutting off water which could cause frozen pipes. However, the Village of Farwell office must still follow the same procedure as they would during the other months to collect utility money.

The normal process is to print utility bills, stamp the bills shut off and give the shut off date, and mail the bills. A few days (usually 48-72 hours) before the shut off date the DPW hangs door knockers as a reminder and courtesy of the Village for those to pay their bill. Lastly, if the bill still has not been paid the office creates work orders for the DPW to shut off the water service at said addresses.

During the winter months the Village has opted to not shut off water but still hold the residents liable for their bills by charging them a \$25 fee if the process makes it to the day the shut off would occur. The fee is what the Village currently charges residents to turn their water back on after a shut off, so the fee would act as if the resident had been shut off. Adding this fee will prevent accounts from exceeding over \$200 or in some cases more than that.

To avoid a shut off fee residents must call or come in to work out a payment plan or agreement with the Village Office prior to the shut off date. If a bill is not paid by or on the shut off date then the \$25 fee will be added the following day.
