Water rates are going to change to the following:

Account Type	Meter Size	Min. Water Use	Min. Monthly Charge
Residential	3/4"	3,500 Gal	\$33.04
Commercial/Industrial	3/4"	3,500 Gal	\$38.99
Commercial/Industrial	1"	6,000 Gal	\$57.67
Commercial/Industrial	1-1/2"	10,500 Gal	\$99.55
Commercial/Industrial	2"	14,000 Gal	\$233.06
Commercial/Industrial	3"	35,000 Gal	\$433.00
Commercial/Industrial	4"	56,000 Gal	\$670.55

The customer will pay \$1.47 per 1,000 gallons of any fraction thereof for each additional 1,000 gallons used over the monthly minimum gallons use authorized for the meter size installed.



Friday, April 26 will be our village clean-up day. Starting at 10:00am in the park. Hope to see you there!



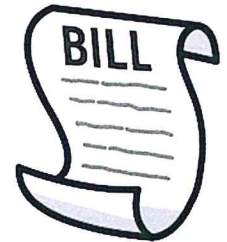

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 1993-5

The Village of Farwell Ordinance #1993-5 states that any weeds, grass or deleterious unhealthful growths or other noxious matter which are higher than 12 inches in height after May 1st may be cut by representatives of the Village Council. All charges shall be due and payable by said owner.
